Birds. The 125 bird species found in the watershed include spotted owl and marbled murrelet, which are listed as threatened under the federal Endangered Species Act. See a list of bird species documented to occur within the watershed (pdf). The watershed includes a variety of habitat types for birds, including old-growth and second-growth coniferous forest; deciduous, riparian forest; meadows and wetlands; streams, lakes, and ponds; and subalpine ridgetops.
