The couple must have lived continuously separate and apart, where at least one person intends for that separation to be permanent, for at least one (1) year and one (1) day before the divorce can be filed.

About Divorce Records in North Carolina. Divorce records are managed by the North Carolina Vital Records Unit, which is a division of the Department of Health and Human Services. Divorce records are available from 1958 to present. Certified copies of vital records are available only to the registrant, spouse, sibling, direct ancestor, direct descendant, stepparent, stepchild, persons needing information for a legal determination of personal or property rights, or an authorized agent ...

North Carolina Divorce Records. Ever since 1962 up to these days, North Carolina Divorce Records have been archived by the authorities working for the state's Vital Records office in Raleigh. Alternatively, people may look up to such identical legal documents at the Register of Deeds from the County where the license was issued.

The North Carolina Judicial Branch publishes a divorce pamphlet with forms and instructions. Additionally, Legal Aid of North Carolina publishes its own Do It Yourself Divorce Packet . All of the forms will have blanks for "Plaintiff" and "Defendant."

On day 31 or after, go to the clerk's office and leave the Judgment for Absolute Divorce Before the Clerk (AOC-CV-710) (3 copies) and Certificate of Absolute Divorce or Annulment (AOC-CV-711) (3 copies). 2. Go to nccourts.org/ Click on Forms, put in form number, and fill out online. 3. Clerk will review the court file and sign the Order.

(if you served the original documents by certified or registered mail) -Return by Sheriff Certificate of Absolute Divorce This form is required by the state of North Carolina and is NOT in your packet. One copy goes into your file and the other goes to the NC Bureau of Vital Records. You must have this before the judge on the date of your divorce.

(Please be aware that N.C. Vital Records is the only place to get a birth certificate for an adopted child.) North Carolina divorce records can be obtained on the same day only if patrons visit the Raleigh Health and Human Services Department of Vital Records. All other counties must wait until the request has been submitted and processed. The office is open weekdays from 8 to 3 PM.

In North Carolina, the grounds for divorce are that the couple must have lived separate and apart for one year and that one party must have resided in North Carolina for six months prior to the filing of the action. A legal separation does not entitle a person to remarry, but a legally separated spouse may obtain orders for:
