(1) When you apply for Basic Food, we decide who is in your assistance unit (AU) based on the requirements under WAC 388-408-0034 and 388-408-0035 .

The amount of food stamps benefits you qualify for is directly related to your income and the number of people in your household. Washington Food Stamp Program - Supplemental Nutrition ...

The amount a household receives each month depends on the household's countable income and size of the household. Eligible households use SNAP benefits to buy food products from authorized stores statewide. Eligible applicants must pass income and assets tests. The gross monthly income test is based on 130% of the current Alaska poverty standard.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

(a) If your AU is categorically eligible as under WAC 388-414-0001, your AU does not have to meet the gross or net income standards in columns B and C of subsection (1) of this section. We budget your AU's income to decide the amount of basic food your AU will receive.

WAC 388-478-0060:

Your household income must be less than the program income limits for your household size. With some exceptions, you must work or participate in an employment and training program. Resources must be under \$5,000 to qualify for Food Stamps.

Who is eligible?

The Washington Basic Food Program operates under the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services. This program provides food assistance to individuals and families with low income salaries. The program has helped thousands of people within the state and ensures that they have healthy food to eat on a regular basis.

Seattle, Washington Food Stamp & SNAP Eligibility

Basic Food is a food and nutrition program for individuals & families who meet the income guideline (listed at right) afford healthier foods by providing monthly benefits to buy food. Basic Food will also qualify you for Free or Reduced School Meals for your child. Eligibility. Eligibility is based on income, family size, and citizenship status.
