Bach's Inventions - the 15 two-part small musical compositions - was the basis of how Johann Sebastian Bach instructed his pupils. The pieces represent the "pillars of artistic piano playing" as József Gát, the editor of the Hungarian edition aptly put it.

Learning from J.S. Bach: The Two-Part Inventions
Bach's inventions are solid early-advanced level pieces. They're written in two parts, which means each hand is playing a melody. These inventions are a great preparation for the more difficult Bach pieces that involve more than two voices (his fugues are in 3-4 parts). All of the inventions are a grade 7 or 8 level on the piano (Henle 3-4).

While giving the player a superb example of musical construction, they also teach the basics of articulation, rhythm, phrasing, fingering, ornamentation, and the development of a singing tone. These short masterpieces are essential repertoire for every pianist.

The Bach Two-Part inventions were composed as teaching pieces and appear in ascending order by pitch, starting with C and using only those Major and minor keys with no more than four sharps or flats. All Inventions, clearly engraved on two pages with no page turns, include editorial markings and suggested tempi.

The 15 Two-Part Inventions are written in the 15 keys that were at the time considered to be standard for keyboard use (remember that the Well-Tempered Clavier, which explores all 24 keys, was a novelty made possible only by the advent of more sophisticated tuning systems).
