New European Pellet Standard – EN 14961-1 2 of this classification is that the producer and the consumer may agree upon characteristics case-by-case. Demolition wood is not included in the scope of the EN 14961-1. The most significant characteristics are mandatory, normative, and shall be given in the fuel specification EN 14961-1.

The EU pellet standard EN 14961-2 is an important step to create a harmonised set of pellet qualities. A solid EU quality certification scheme is crucial to simplify work of the pellets producers and increase confidence by pellets equipment manufacturers and consumers. So far only national schemes have been developed.

Having a pellet with a consistent length, diameter and bulk density is important, as wood pellet boilers are designed to use pellets with a standard energetic density (i.e. energy content per unit of volume). Using the wrong sized pellet will affect the energetic density.

New European standards for solid biomass fuels have been introduced in 2011. They include a standard for wood pellets (EN 14961-2) which EN plus helps to implement all over Europe. The individual national standards are no longer valid. EN 14961-2 was superceded by ISO 17225-2 standard in 2014.

European standard committee CEN/TC 335 Finally, the European Standard Committee CEN/TC 335 is the technical committee that has developed the draft standard to describe all forms of solid biofuel in Europe, including wood chips, wood pellets and briquettes, logs, sawdust, and straw bales.

A review of European standards for pellet quality ...

According to ENplus standard, grade A1 and A2 wood pellets have sulfur content less than 0.03%, and grade B is less than 0.04%. The sulfur content in wood pellets can meet the environmental standard of the country.

Wood pellet specification and standard

The EN plus pellets The EN refers to European Norm. The EN plus pellet certification system has been introduced in Germany in 2010. Since then it has spread fast to the surrounding countries such as Austria, Belgium, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, United Kingdom and even the US.

The certification process is carried out by the certification bodies who strictly follow all the standards as laid down by the DIN Certco.
