After an organ transplant, you will need to take immunosuppressant (anti-rejection) drugs. These drugs help prevent your immune system from attacking ("rejecting") the donor organ.

Living donors are seen by the transplant team between two and six weeks after donation, and are recommended to attend an annual follow-up appointment for the rest of their lives. There is a small possibility of a slight rise in blood pressure and excess protein in a donor's urine after donating a kidney.
