Roman de la rose, (French: "Romance of the Rose") one of the most popular French poems of the later Middle Ages. Modeled on Ovid's *Ars amatoria* (c. 1 bc; Art of Love), the poem is composed of more than 21,000 lines of octosyllabic couplets and survives in more than 300 manuscripts. Little is known of the author of the first 4,058 lines except his name, Guillaume de Lorris, and thus his birth in Lorris, a village near Orléans.
