It was also used by Persianate societies such as the rulers and offspring of the Ottoman Empire, Mughal India, Bengal Sultanate, Gorkha, and Afghanistan. In Iran the title was continuously used; rather than King in the European sense, each Iranian and Timurid Indian emperor regarded himself as the Shahanshah or Padishah of the Persian Empire.
